# **RBI to withdraw** ₹2,000 notes from circulation

# **NOTES CAN BE EXCHANGED, DEPOSITED UP TO SEPT 30**

#### **NEW DELHI**

In a surprise move, the Reserve Bank on Friday announced withdrawal of Rs 2,000 currency notes from circulation but gave public time till September 30 to either deposit such notes in accounts

or exchange them at banks. Unlike the November 2016 shock demonetisation when old Rs 500 and Rs 1,000 notes were invalidated overnight, the Rs 2,000 notes will continue to be a legal tender till September 30.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI), however, did not say what would be the status of 2,000 notes in private hands after September 30. Earlier, the government had made it an offence to hold the demon-

# Salaries of civic chiefs, councillors to double

The State government has proposed almost doubling the salaries of chairpersons and councillors of municipal councils in the State.

The proposal to amend the Goa Municipalities (Chairperson's and other Councillor's Emoluments) Rules, 1970, was pre-published in the form of a notification by Gurudas Pilarnekar, the Director of Municipal Administration and Urban Development, who is also ex-officio Additional Secretary to the government.

According to the changed rules, chairpersons of the three classes of municipalities

(A. B and C) will get monthly emoluments of Rs 25,000, Rs 22,000 and Rs 20,000 respectively. They currently draw Rs 12,825, Rs 11,475 and Rs

10,800. Also, councillors of these three classes of municipalities will draw an uniform Rs 18,000 monthly once the amended rules come into force. Currently these councillors are drawing Rs 10,800, Rs 10,125 and Rs 9,450 respec-

tively every month. Pilarnekar said the new rules will come into force when Goa Municipalities (Chairperson's and other Emoluments) Councillor's Amendment Rules, 2023, is published in official gazette.

# **HC slams babus for misusing** powers under Section 144

The High Court of Bombay at Goa has expressed disappointment over the recent trend of authorities misusing and exploiting their powers.

# **Objections pour in against** changes to building laws

### **NGO SUBMITS LETTER OBJECTING TO MOST OF PROPOSALS**

With the May 26 deadline nearing, objections to the sweeping changes proposed in the Goa Land Development & Building Construction Regulations, have begun flowing in at the office of the Chief Town Planner (Planning) Rajesh Naik.

Meanwhile, a number of other organisations and green activists have over the past several days been holding consultations on these sweeping changes in the building laws proposed by the TCP department.

According to noted environmental architect Elsa Fernandes, who has crisscrossed the length and breadth of the State to explain the implications of these sweeping changes, several more representations with objections are expected to be filed before the CTP over the next week.

"There are some organisations who are still holding consultations and discussions over the proposed amendments. Others are busy putting together all their objections on paper. Over the next week until the Friday deadline, dozens more representations will be filed,' Fernandes said.

the Southwest monsoon hits Kerala on June 1. The normal date of onset of monsoon in Goa is June 5 which is four days after it ar rives in Kerala.

But since the onset of the monsoon in Kerala is likely to be delayed by four days, it is also expected to be delayed in the State.

"We cannot say anything about the onset of monsoon in Goa as there are no such re ports available from IMD Del hi." Scientist Raieshree said. Meanwhile, the IMD has said that conditions were favourable for further advance of the Southwest monsoon into some more parts of the South Bay of Bengal, Andaman Sea and Andaman & Nicobar Islands during the next three to four days.

# **Ripped up roads of Mapusa pose threat to commuters**

Locals raise concern, say if roads not patched up then disaster is waiting this monsoon

Development comes at a price and nobody will know it bet ter than the citizens of Panaji. But people in the capital city are not the only ones to face such hardships, similar problems are staring in the face of the residents of Mapusa too.

Negotiating through the dugup roads in Mapusa's central square has become painful due to the ongoing underground power line cabling work.

Thanks to Swastika, which has bagged the contract of laying the underground cabling project, several main roads were ripped open and while some stretches have been refilled, there is no sign of tarring the roads

"It's so difficult to negotiate through the uneven roads. All the key roads around the market were dug up. They have filled some of the roads with rubble but the mud and loose gravel make it difficult for traffic to negotiate," rued Rajendra Naik, a resident of Mapusa.

Like Naik, many others complain about the problem of commuting through the uneven roads in town.

The main roads near the Suraj book stall, Dalal newspaper agency, SBI, around the municipal garden and near St Xavier's College have been dug up and badly bruised to shift the 33KV HT line underground. Cars, bikes and even buses

were seen moving dangerously while trying to negotiate the broken roads. "These contractors have a habit to dig roads anytime, sometimes without even displaying the warning signages. The district collector should not allow the digging of roads one month before the monsoon. Even if the roads are tarred now, in the rains, the road will sink and create problems for the movement of traf-

fic," said Peter D'Sa, a resident of Angod, Mapusa.

Locals are worried that if these roads are not patched up with asphalt then disaster is waiting to happen in the monsoons. While the electricity department has taken up the soling work of the dug-up roads, the PWD (roads) is responsible to tar the roads.

A senior official of the PWD (roads) informed that the work to repair the recently dug-up roads in Mapusa has been tendered but the work order has not been issued yet. "As soon as we get the work order, the patch-up work of various roads in town will be taken up immediately," the official informed.

#### HOTMIXING OF KEY MAPUSA ROAD DELAYED YET AGAIN

MAPUSA: While the Electricity department has decided to remove all the old cemented electricity poles along the road from Union Pharmacy to the Mapusa urban bank on Sunday, the chances of hot-mixing the entire road up to the Mapusa church are dim.

Around five years ago, the Goa State Urban Development Ágency (GSUDA) had taken up the beautification of the road stretch with a plan to remove the overhead wires and push it underground. The road was also supposed to get a divider with two-arm fancy light poles. We are removing the old poles and the

"Although the tender to hotmix the road has been passed, the work order has not been issued and is not likely to be taken up before the monsoons," an official informed.

# K'taka impasse ends, lessons to learn for **Congress** in Goa

he Congress came out unscathed on the Karnataka leadership issue after a prolonged period of indecisiveness and a picture of Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge in celebratory mode with frontrunner Siddaramaiah and strong contender DK Shivakumar in tow said it all. Amid fears of Karnataka going the Rajasthan way for Congress, the party leadership pulled itself together, settled the math between the two leaders, and did what it had to do to ensure that there is no collateral damage.

The re-emergence of Congress in neighbouring Karnataka saw partymen in Goa go ecstatic with a rush of adrenaline in a motley group that was distraught and directionless till now. However, while the Karnataka win is inspiring, partymen back home must introspect on how this inspiration can rub on to them in the run-up to the Lok Sabha election.

In Karnataka, two tall leaders of Congress buried the hatchet and interests while agreeing to work together in the larger interest of the party. For now, this is a template the Congress would like to set for all

other States where it is competing for political space. In Goa, while there were celebrations over Karnataka, the functioning of the party remains a picture of incomparable contrast.

Consider this: While the BJP has descended on the ground campaigning for the Lok Sabha election next year, the Congress remains scattered projecting itself like a small bunch of people with varied

aims and targets. Sitting South Goa MP Francisco Sardinha is fighting an internal rebellion and does not have unanimous support for his candidacy, Goa Pradesh Congress Committee President Amit Patkar, a new face in the party, is struggling to find his feet and the chaos is only making his job difficult, leader of the Opposition Yuri Alemao is the lone man fighting, Aldona MLA Carlos Alvares remains patchy and former GPCC president Girish Chodankar is fighting his own battle from outside the boundary.

The few others who are protesting on the ground don't have the bandwidth to make a mark and cut out a sorry picture. The Congress is reduced to a party of assorted leaders with conflicting agendas. Worse still is the fact that Manickam Tagore who was appointed as the new AII India Congress Committee (AICC) in charge of Goa in January this year replacing Dinesh Gundu Rao, has failed to make his

he ambitious plan of the previous BJP-led Karnataka Government to divert the waters of the Mhadei basin in order to feed the various irrigation and hydro-electric projects in its own state would obviate pronounced water shortages downstream into Goa thus leading to a divestiture of sustenance to the endemic flora and fauna whose habitat is invariably predicated upon the waters from the Mhadei basin propelling the continuity of life in the affected regions.

An appurtenant aspect which had earlier prompted the diversion of the waters from the Mhadei basin was the approval and notification of the Detailed Project Report (DPR) by the BJP-led Central government.

As per the common presumptions in Political Science which govern the 'federal structure of state polity' it is common knowledge that power and responsibility are distributed across different layers of the government.

Realistically, India is a federal system but with more of a tilt towards a unitary system of government. It has sometimes been considered as a quasi-federal system which exhibits features of both a federal and a unitary system of governance. Article 1 of the Indian Constitution states, 'India, that is Bharat, shall be a union of states

Hence, until the Union government was led by the BJP and the Karnataka State government was also led by the regional members of the BJP, the hierarchical presuppositions which dictate the flow of power from the Union to the States would be seamless until that time when the beneficial arrangement continues.

But what happens when the Union government is fed by a different political ideology and the respective State government is subjugated upon the rebelliousness of its approach to politics as a secular force

And moreover, what could be expected when the State which has been afflicted by the Centre's decision to approve the DPR pertaining to the diversification of the Mhadei waters happens to be led by factions of the BJP that are subservient to the central nationalist political ideology. The formula is more or less straightfor-

ward: Union Government (BJP) plus the Goa State Government (BJP) minus the Kar-



nataka State Government (Congress) in implementing the decisions which would ultimately impact the continual flow of the Mhadei river into Goa.

And to afford context to the above equation, it would only be apt to mention that the present State government in Karnataka as of 13th May, 2023 is predominantly occupied by majority members of the Indian National Congress.

In order to afford context to the ensuing academic rhetoric, it would be appropriate to enunciate that the United Progressive Alliance (UPA) (Sanskrit: Sa yukt Pragatish l Ga habandhan) is a centre-left political alliance in India led by the Indian National Congress (INC).

According to Subrata K. Mitra (2011) in the Contemporary South Asia Jour nal at Volume 19, Issue 2 has sought to explain the resilience of India's democracy in terms of the persistence of significant legislative output and policy continuity despite noisy adversarial politics.

The article entitled: "Adversarial politics and policy continuity: the UPA NDA and the resilience of democracy in India" compared two different national regimes - one by the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance government (NDA), 1999–2004, and the other by the Congress-led United Progressive Alli ance (UPA), 2004–2009.

Accordingly, the findings were:

"Despite their rather different ap proaches to citizenship - the former, based on Hindu nationalism, and the latter, a more inclusive, 'secular' conception of citizenship - there is considerable convergence in legislative regimes, institutions to safeguard the interest of minorities and public subsidy...

"Turning subjects into citizens - no doubt with a sharp eye to their electoral potential – has become accepted prac tice by both competing coalitions."

"Despite its occasional breakdown the paradoxical juxtaposition of adversarial politics and policy continuity is achieved because of the existence of a broad inter-party consensus on one coherent and meaningful citizenship regime and the high trust in which me diating institutions like the Supreme Court and the Election Commission are held.'

Ghatak et al. (2014) in their seminal article entitled "Growth in the Time of UPA Myths and Reality" published in the Economic & Political Weekly had challenged the prevailing view that the diminished electoral prospects of the United Progressive Alliance government was the result of neglecting growth to launch populist welfare schemes.

After having looked at a wide range of economic indicators thus comparing the performance of the UPA (United Progressive Alliance) to the National Dem ocratic Alliance (NDA) regime, the UPA period has been characterised by faster growth, higher savings and investment growing foreign trade and capital inflows, and increased infrastructure spending in partnership with private capital.

The UPA's political troubles arose not from policies that hurt growth but from an inability to tackle the consequences of accelerated economic growth at the time, which included: an increased con flict over land, rent seeking and corrup tion in the booming infrastructure and natural resource sectors, the inability of public education to keep up with increased demand and rising aspirations and a poor delivery of welfare schemes that were made possible by growing revenues.

Consequently, the rift between the Congress and the BJP governance struc tures are pronounced and to a certain extent even prolific in their ideologica inclinations. The concern which should arise in the mind of every Goan now is whether the Congress-led Karnataka State Government would adopt derisive measures in diverting the Mhadei Wa ters to the detriment of the Goan Ecolo gy or would it adapt into a more concil iatory approach towards environmental conservation that is deep rooted in their party's ethos i.e. 'Secularism' and 'So cial democracy'.

Whatever may be the approach of the newly formed Karnataka State Govern ment on the Mhadei issue, the BJP-led Goa government ought not to forget its dedication to the Goan cause of protect ing the flow and course of the Mhade along the Goan river banks.

If there are lessons to be learnt on unity, then Karnataka becomes a classic case for Goa. The central command must show the same urgency that it showed in Karnataka and set a hierarchy and discipline in place so that rebuilding can begin right away. Against the giant-killing effort in Karnataka where the BJP lay decimated, the Congress in Goa appears back-broken by defections and is currently incapable of even projecting itself as the principal Opposition. Other political outfits like Aam Aadmi Party and Revolutionary Goan Party are fast gaining traction and getting noticed even by the ruling party.

# Dhirio is different from Jallikattu

he Supreme Court on Thursday upheld the constitutional validity of state laws framed to allow bull taming sport Jallikattu in Tamil Nadu, buffalo racing (Kambala) in Karnataka and bullock cart race in Maharashtra saying that there are sufficient provisions to prevent cruelty to animals in these ancient sports

Incidentally in Goa 'Dhirios', which has two bulls pitted against one another, have been banned for the violation of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act. Jallikattu, a bull-taming sport from Tamil Nadu is celebrated to worship cattle stock and is observed during Pongal. It is learnt that just like human beings while exercising the body feel the endorphins flow through them, similarly the sport of Jallikattu increases the testosterone levels in the bulls so when the breeding season that follows after Pongal they are virile and that gives way for birth of strong offspring.

Kambala is an annual festival celebrated in the Dakshina Kannada district of Karnataka. The festival involves the traditional buffalo race, a popular and unique sport among the farming community of the state. The Apex Court verdict has also allowed bullock-cart races in Maharashtra. However, bull fight 'Dhirio', which is a very popular game in Goa is different. The bulls are bred and trained to fight and the game attracts huge crowds. Goan bull fighting involves huge betting.

#### HC slams babus for misusing powers under Section 144

The petitioner had challenged the District Magistrate's order dated December 28, 2022 banning the couple from carrying out religious activities at their property in Siolim 'to curb religious conversion by means of allurement or fraud affecting the freedom of religion and conscience of citizens.

The North District Police and the Collector, who were among the respondents citing as many as eight First Information Reports (FIRs) against the couple since 2009; but the Court observed that these cases either ended in acquittal/discharge or filing of C Summary reports.

....If were considered by the District Magistrate, would have obviously resulted in the District Magistrate refraining from passing the impugned order. There was clearly no material before the District Magistrate to proceed in terms of the provisions of Section 144 to record any subjective satisfaction. The central rules also speak about setting up modern vehicle scrapping facilities to recycle vehicles in an environment-friendly manner. "The RVSF policy will help in increasing automobile sales, provide employment, reduce import cost, generate incremental GST revenue and help to solve the global shortage of semi-conductor chips," it said.

Considering the increasing level of vehicular pollution by old vehicles, the State has already imposed a "Green Tax" as per Section 3(A) of Goa Daman and Diu Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1974 for the renewal of registration of non-transport vehicles and transport vehicles above 15 years.

The State government while promoting the use of battery-operated vehicles has exempted the registration fees, motor vehicle tax and permit.

#### RBI to withdraw ₹2,000 notes from circulation

Former Finance Secretary S C Garg said the latest move is aimed at reducing dependence on high denomination currency notes and promote digital payments.

Half of the Rs 2,000 denomination notes issued as part of remonetisation were alreadv withdrawn from the system and remaining will go out of system through today's decision, Garg said.

As of March 2023, Rs 2,000 notes made up for almost 11 per cent of currency in circulation. In a statement, the RBI said it has asked banks to stop issuing Rs 2,000 notes with immediate effect.

While the RBI did not specify a limit for depositing the Rs 2,000 currency notes in bank accounts, exchange of a maximum of Rs 20,000 (10 notes of Rs 2,000) for other currency notes will be allowed at a time.

The move comes amid concerns of the highest denomination notes being used to hoard black money. The RBI had stopped printing Rs 2,000 notes in 2018-19 and the notes were rarely in circulation.

The Rs 2,000 denomination bank note was introduced in November 2016, primarily to meet the currency requirement of the economy in an expeditious manner after the withdrawal of legal tender status of all Rs 500 and Rs 1,000 bank notes in circulation at that time. The RBI said it has also been observed that Rs 2.000 denomination note is not commonly used for transactions. Further, the stock of bank notes in other denominations continues to be adequate to meet the currency requirement of the public, it added.

"In view of the above, and in pursuance of the "Clean Note Policy" of the Reserve Bank of India, it has been decided to withdraw the Rs 2,000 denomination bank notes from circulation," it said.

The bank notes in Rs 2.000 denomination will continue to be a legal tender, it added. The central bank has asked the public to deposit Rs 2,000 bank notes into their bank accounts and/or exchange them into banknotes of other denominations at any bank branch. "Members of the public are encouraged to utilise the time up to September 30, 2023 to deposit and/or exchange the Rs 2,000 bank notes," the central bank said.

# The St Anne Chapel in St Estevao

#### FR APOLLO CARDOZO SJ

he chapel dedicated to St Anne, the mother of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the wife of St Joaquim, is in Mangueiral vaddo in Santo Estevao. Liturgical services are held here once a week by priests from the church. The feast is celebrated this year on Saturday, May 20.

#### ORIGIN

In the days of old, there when there was no public transport, Catholics residing in Mangueiral vaddo, especially the elders and the infirm, would find it quite difficult to participate in the religious services in the Church, which was quite a distance away. Hence, they felt the need to have a place of worship here. Ligorio Simpliciano Fulgencio Pereira and Apolinia Visitacao de Sequeira, widow of Flaviano Antonio de Fonseca, residents of this vaddo, gifted a small part of their property for the construction of the chapel here, which was blessed on January 30, 1915.

#### **EXTENSION**

In 1920, the parish priest, Fr Antonio Leandro Roberto de Rosa, whose basque is mount ed on a pedestal just outside the chapel, reconstructed and extended it. During the Novena or Feast Day or when any special religious services were held here, the chapel could not accommodate all the faithful. Hence the outside of the chapel, adrar, which has the appearance of amphitheatre or an open auditorium with

tiers of seating arrangement, was used during this time. In 2006, a ceiling was erected over it by the villagers. The chapel has three entrances, the left side in the past was meant for women while the right for men. Above the main entrance of the chapel is a lateral belfry tower having a medium size bell.

#### ALTAR

The altar is dedicated to the patroness, St Anne, whose image is in the centre of the arcade behind. In front of it is a large and richly adorned altar, with two beautiful engraving spiral pillars that beautify the main altar, pilasters and other

embellishments, with coping attached to the chanel is the vestry room to store vestments stone in the centre. and other chapel material.

Below the altar piece, is a painting depicting three themes. On the left is the Triadology - the doctrine of Trinity, the Supreme Supernatural Mystery of the Holy Trinity -Father, Son and the Holy Spirit. In the centre is the picture of St Anne. The third painting is that of Lamb of God, symbolising our Lord Jesus Christ and hovering above is the Dove symbolising the Holy Spirit.

The sanctuary of the chapel is separated by a communion rail of carved teak wood which earlier was meant for the women to receive Holy Communion kneeling down, while men received Holy Communion in the sanctuary near the altar. After the first column of the chapel on the right side, is a square platform of stones, which is used usually on the feast of St.

n a unique initiative, the Joseph Rufino Cordeiro Foundation has announced a collaboration with the University of Oxford on May 12, to sponsor inaugural summer research studentships in Sustainable Chemistry and accommodation at Worcester College to encourage and nurture Goan or Indian students.

The Joseph Rufino Cordeiro Foundation has been founded by Mary Anne Cordeiro to honour the memory and legacy of her late father, Joseph Rufino Cordeiro, a brilliant Goan scientist and inventor, whose expertise in radio navigational aids and communication became recognised worldwide.

#### **EARLY LIFE**

Rufino was born in Mombasa, Kenya, on April 23, 1924, but went to school in Goa. Belgaum and Pune, while his mother completed the construction of their family home in Saligao

"He was a polymath and although his passion was always science and medicine, Rufino eventually graduated with a BSc from Ferguson College in Physics and an MSc in Electronics awarded by St Xavier's College, University of Bombay,' informed his daughter Mary Anne.

Rufino's first professional role was in Gwalior where he was hired by the Holkar to run his private airport, but his father was keen that Rufino relocate to Kenya where he believed his son would be able to find better prospects.

#### **ACHIEVEMENTS**

As his father predicted, Rufino transitioned quickly into a prestigious job with International Aeradio (IAL) in Nairobi in 1952, and later was head consultant of the Directorate of Civil Aviation in Kenya. There, he met his future wife soon after he arrived in Nairobi, and they married after his 7-year single-minded courtship of Lira in 1959

In 1969, the young family moved to the UK for the sake of their three daughters' education. Rufino continued to work for IAL in London for another 10 years, during which his expertise in radio navigational aids and communication became recognised worldwide.

He continued to work in similar roles for other international aeronautic companies until he retired in 1989. His design skills were utilised around the world in 27 international airports, including Abu Dhabi, Brunei, Malawi, Mauritius, Nige-

He was delighted to become president of the Saligao Association UK in 1977 and sponsor the Mae De Deus Feast in Saligao in May 1984. Everyone who knew him considered him to be a gentleman of great integrity, strong faith and deep convictions," added Mary Anne.

Rufino passed away at the age of 96 at his family home in Bray, Berkshire on January 5, 2021.

# **GOAN CHAMPION GUARDIAN OF TREES – 1** Moving from UK to Kenya, taking first steps in agriculture

Olaf Ribeiro thought he would spend the rest of his life in Britain when he got word from his mother that Kenya was preparing for independence and was looking for citizens to train to take over the agriculture in the country.

#### **FAMED GRANDFATHER**

Dr Olaf Ribeiro is the grandson of the pioneer Kenvan-Goan doctor Rosendo Ribeiro, who was conferred an OBE by Britain in 1932 and the award of Commander of The Order of Benemerencia from the Portuguese government in 1947.

Dr Rosendo, who was born in Porvorim in 1870 and moved to Mombasa-Kenya to work as a doctor in 1899, discovered a cure for malaria which he sold to the British in exchange for land. The British went on to profit handsomely from this transaction. He also discovered the Bubonic plague and developed a cure for it. He was also responsible for being a founding member of the Dr Ribeiro Goan School in Nairobi, many of whose alumni went on to become outstanding members of the community. Dr Rosendo died in 1951, aged 80. His remains are interred at the City Park cemetery in Parklands, Nairobi.


Dr Rosendo was famous for riding a zebra on his visits to patients. He later sold



the animal to the Bombay Zoo.

#### **RETURN TO KENYA**

Recalls Dr Olaf Ribeiro, "I flew home to Kenya, interviewed with the Ministry of Agriculture and in short order was giv-

"All of us had previously been working in different jobs including Customs Officers, Desk Clerks and Accountants. Very few of us had any idea of agriculture! This was to be a grand experiment in getting Kenya ready for independence. The college was a previously all-white college set up to train the sons of white farmers to farm. The instructors came from Britain, the US (on a foreign aid programme), an Australian and a Dane.'

"Students were British sons of local farmers, Indians (Muslims, Hindus, Sikhs, and Goans), natives from various tribes (some traditionally hostile to each other!) and even an Italian student, Luigi, whose parents were farming in Somalia."

"We all shared the same dormitories. Amazingly, there were very few skirmishes although there were occasional skirmishes with the white British kids who greatly resented us "coloureds" in what was formerly a white domain. In fact, the manager of the estate Major Thornton, could not handle the fact that the place now had "coloured" students on the premises. He settled the issue by committing suicide with a shotgun to his head.'

#### **PRACTICAL EDUCATION**

Dr Olaf Ribeiro said the farm consisted

of both animal husbandry and agronomy units.

"It was the most complete education that anyone could ask for in agriculture and animal farming, including wheat, barley, potatoes, and pyrethrum as well as milking cows, castrating piglets, shearing sheep, treating sick animals and learning to drive tractors and combine harvesters.

"We also learnt how to slaughter ani mals for our meals and to use the remains to study anatomy. I had my fair share of mishaps from shearing off the teats of a sheep to killing another by pressing too hard on the animal's neck as I held it be tween my legs to shear it!"

In time, Dr Olaf got to manage the agronomy farm when the farm manager left for overseas leave to Britain.

"These were the early days of Uhuru and much of the colonial influence was still alive and well. It was a pretty swell life, the students had a bar (which they welcomed with Kenyan joy), played hock ey and soccer and competed with teams from as far as Nairobi, Mombasa and Kampala.

Life was bliss, especially when the pitch-black Kenyan night delivered a su per-scope canvas full of stars, sometimes a comet or two and regular shooting stars. It was a kind of heaven," said Dr Olaf.

# Helping African Goans resettle in UK influenced my political career: Rabi

Nine-time councillor Rabi Martins had rare opportunity to serve as mayor twice

etting elected as a councillor has now become a regular feature for former mayor of Goan origin and sitting councillor Rabi Martins from the Liberal Democrat Party, after he was elected nine times to the Watford Council in Hertfordshire-UK.

Rabi, who will be sworn in on May 23, also has the rare distinction of having served as mayor on two separate occasions.

Having lived in Goa, Pune, Tanzania, Dublin and Watford, Rabi has imbibed different values which has shaped and influenced his politics and social work.

#### BACKGROUND

Hailing from Varca, Rabi is the son of Dr Minguelinho Martins and Lilia Viegas. His primary education was in Varca and Pune, while he completed his secondary education in Dar es Salaam and Dodoma (Tanzania).

He went on to pursue his graduation in BSc at Dublin and also completed his MBA

Besides politics, Rabi has had interests

in various fields. In sports, he captained the school and college hockey teams, while he has also pursued photography, writing, travel, human rights and racial justice.


"I have also had an interest in community work. My first experience was when my school gave shelter to refugees from the Belgian Congo and I was part of the support team," recalled Rabi.

#### **POLITICAL JOURNEY**

Rabi said his interest in politics was stirred by Julius Nyerere who led the independence movement in what is now Tanzania. His other political influencers were John F Kennedy and Nelson Mandela.

"My interest in racial justice came to the fore when I first came to the UK in 1965 to be confronted by notices for accommodation in shop windows saying 'No Blacks - No Irish - No Dogs' and advertisements for jobs carrying the message 'Blacks Need Not Apply'.

"I joined various groups to campaign for racial justice and our work led to the introduction of the Race Relations Act 1976. We also set up the Goan Association Standing Committee on Race and Immigration, which I had the privilege

to chair.'

"At this time, I was invited to serve on the executive committee of the UK Immigrants Service.'

Following the eviction of Asians from Uganda by Idi Amin, Rabi was invited to join the Uganda Asians Resettlement Board.

"The evacuees included a large number of Goans and I was pleased to be able to assist some of them make a new home in the UK." said Rabi.

It was this sort of activity that brought Rabi into contact with the political system.



"In 1992, I was invited to stand for election as a councillor. I did but lost the election. I stood a second time in 1993 and came close. I won the seat on my

third attempt in 1994, but lost the seat in 1998. I regained the seat in 1999 and have held it ever since," said Rabi.

In that period, Rabi had the rare privilege of serving as Chairman of the Council (Civic Mayor) on two separate occasions, in 2006-7 and 2017-18.

"I am currently vice-chair of the Planning Committee and the Council Mental Health Champion. I also stood as a Par-

liamentary Candidate in four general elections, but failed to get elected.'

"Beyond Council work, I played an active part within the national Liberal Democrat Party and held various roles including Advisor to the Party Chief Executive. Member of Federal International Relations Committee, Federal Policy Committee and Regional Diversity Officer," added Rabi.

#### **SOCIAL WORK**

Outside of politics, Rabi is currently Vice President of Watford Rotary Club, having previously served as President

and District Assistant Governor. He is currently preparing for the Rotary Club Centenary Celebrations in February 2024

"In 2020, I visited Amritsar with fellow UK Rotarians to support the India Polio Immunisation programme. I am also very involved with the scouts movement and serve as current District Vice President of Watford North Scouts District, said Rabi.

"At the moment, I partner with celebrated former England footballer and Watford player Luther Blissett OBE to support Ukranian refugees in Watford.'

"I am a very 'wherever I lay my Head is my Home' kind of person. I guess that comes from the fact that I have led a very nomadic kind of life: born in Goa, and educated in India and Africa. So even though I faced racial discrimination in many quarters, it did not defeat me."

Rabi said his approach to tackling any challenge has always been the same, to tackle it head-on.

"Some battles will be harder than others and I go into these battles knowing I will win some and I will lose some. So, I accept whatever the outcome is and move on.

"Experience has taught me that the most important thing in one's personal life is to have a goal and then to strive to achieve it. Only when you reach it, set a new and more challenging goal. Achieve that one and move ahead with an even more challenging goal," summed up Rabi

#### Britain unveils \$1.2 bn plan to boost chip sector

Britain's government unveiled its longawaited semiconductor strategy on Friday, catching up with similar efforts by Western allies seeking to reduce reliance on Asian production of the computer chips that are essential to modern life.



"Having come this far, we can afford to look at the data and the evolving outlook to make careful assessments," he said, reading from prepared notes.

According to the Bloomberg report, investors pared bets on a rate hike next month to around 17% after Powell's comments compared

with 33% before he spoke Officials raised rates by а quarter percentage point earli-

target range of 5% to 5.25%and signaled they could pause. They next meet June 13-14.

The US central bank has increased interest rates 5 percentage points in little more than a year. undertaking its most aggressive tightening campaign in decades to quell high inflation. But Powell signaled that he isn't in that camp, citing headwinds to the economy stemming from the recent collapse of four regional US banks.

Prices fell despite the amount being sharply higher than the central bank's surplus transfer of 303.07 bln rupees in the previous financial year as well as the budget estimate for the current financial year. Traders sold their gilt holdings because they had broadly expected the dividend payment to be of about 1.0-1.5 trln rupees.

# **Credit card spending** declines 3% in April

Spending through credit cards stood at 1.33 trln rupees in April, down 3.3% on month, but up nearly 26% on year, data from the Reserve Bank of India showed, Credit card spending continued to breach the 1-trln-rupee mark for the 14th consecutive month.

On a month-on-month basis, while spending through online transactions declined by 6.1%, spending though point-of-sale transactions rose 1.4%. The number of transactions outstanding credit cards rose to 86.5 mln as of Apr from 85.3 mln the previous month.

Outstanding credit cards issued by public sector banks and private banks were up by 19.3% on year. However. cards issued by foreign banks were down 31.9% on year.

In terms of new card additions, HDFC Bank topped the charts with 343,054 additions, followed by Axis Bank with

144,809 new cards. ICICI Bank followed suit with 118,485 new credit card addi tions last month. Among public sector banks. Bank of Baroda saw a 0.1% decline on month in its outstanding credit cards, taking its total number of credit cards to 1.95 mln ru pees in April.

On market share, among outstanding credit cards. HDFC Bank maintained its lead position with 20.67% share, followed by State Bank of India with 19.48%. ICICI Bank 16.85%, and Axis Bank at 14.19%.

#### Domestic airlines carried 1.29 cr pax in Apr, up 22% ON TIME DEDEODMANC

Domestic airlines flew 1.29 crore passengers in April, a rise of more than 22 per cent compared to the year-ago period, according to official data released on Friday. However, the domestic air traf-

fic number last month at 128.88 lakh was marginally lower than the 128.93 lakh recorded in March. In April 2022, the number of passengers carried by airlines stood at 105.47 lakh.

"Passengers carried by domestic airlines during January-April 2023 were 503.93 lakh as against

352.70 lakh during the corresponding period of the previous year, thereby registering annual growth of 42.88 per cent and monthly growth of 22.20 per cent,' the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) said on Friday. In terms of On-Time Perform-

ance (OTP) in April, Akasa Air topped at 94 per cent, followed by Air India (91.1 per cent) and Indi-Go (89.6 per cent). Go First, which has suspended

flights from May 3, had the lowest OTP at 41.7 per cent in April.

Vistara's OTP was at 86.5 per cent, followed by AirAsia India

(82.9 per cent), SpiceJet (69.2 per cent) and Alliance Air (67.9 per cent).

In April, IndiGo's domestic market share rose to 57.5 per cent from 56.8 per cent in the previous month.

The market share of Air India declined to 8.6 per cent in April from 8.8 per cent in March, while that of Vistara fell to 8.7 per cent from 8.9 per cent during the same period.

As per the data, AirAsia India's (now AIX Connect) market share remained unchanged at 7.6 per cent in April

#### Govt asks airlines to exercise moderation in pricing tickets amid spike in airfares

The government has asked airlines to exercise moderation and ensure a balance in pricing of air tickets amid a spike in airfares on certain routes especially after suspension of flights by crisis-hit Go First, according to a senior official. While making it clear that there are no plans to regulate airfares, the official said there should not be a huge gap between the tickets sold in the lower and upper fare buckets by the airlines. India is one of the fastest growing civil aviation markets in the world and domestic passenger traffic has been rising after being significantly impacted by the coronavirus pandemic. After cash-strapped Go First stopped flying from May 3, there has been a significant rise in airfares on certain routes that were operated by the budget carrier. The routes include Delhi-Srinagar and Delhi-Pune.



#### **Causes of skin cancer**

The skin has three layers which are known as the epidermis (outer layer of the skin providing protection from bacteria water loss and other harmful substances). dermis (a deep, thick laver beneath the epidermis containing tough connective tissues, sweat glands and hair follicles), and hypodermis (a deeper subcutaneous tissue made of fat and connective tissue).

The epidermis i.e., the outer layer of the skin is always exposed to the environment. The skin cells are shedding daily and new ones are multiplying and forming to replace the dead skin cells. Sometimes, these skin cells can multiply excessively creating a skin tumour that may either be benign or malignant

#### Diagnosing skin cancer

If you notice sudden moles or skin lesions on the back, legs and other parts of the body, consult a doctor. The doctor will first examine the shape, size, colour and texture of the mole and will ask when it first appeared, how much it has increased over time and whether is it painful or itchy.

Based on the appearance of the mole, the doctor will recommend a biopsy which can be done in many ways

Shave biopsy is done if the basal cell or squamous cell carcinoma is suspected. It involves numbing the skin and shaving a piece of the lesion.

■ Incisional biopsy is done by making an incision in the skin lesion and removing an abnormal part for evaluation.

■ Excisional biopsy is done if melanoma is suspected. The doctor removes the entire abnormal skin part for evaluation.

If the skin cancer is in its advanced stage, the doctor will do a sentinel node biopsy, CT scans, PET scan depending on the location of skin cancer

#### **Treatment for skin cancer**

The treatment will depend on the type of cancer, size, location, stage and how much it has spread. Then the doctor will recommend one or more of these treatments which include

• Excision surgery, which is done by cutting out the healthy skin surrounding the mole

• Cryotherapy, which is done by freezing the growth using liquid nitrogen and the tissue is destroyed as it thaws.

 Mohs surgery involves removing excess tissues of the abnormal growth situated layer after layer till no abnormal cells are visible.

• Chemotherapy treatment is done to kill the cancer cells.

• Curettage and electrodesiccation in which is a long-shaped blade used to scrape away the cancer cells and the remaining cells are burnt with an electric needle.

• Radiation therapy is an alternative treatment to surgery where surgery is difficult in places like the eyelids, nose or ears.

• Photodynamic therapy is done to destroy the cancer cells using a laser light.

• Biological therapy is done to stimulate the immune system to fight skin cancer cells.

• Immunotherapy is another treatment where the cream is applied to the skin to trigger the immune system to kill cancer cells.
